

REPLACEMENT POLICY FOR PHAT PHAT SEWA SCHEME

SALIENT FEATURES OF THE SCHEME

1. The scheme is allowed for replacement only for New motor vehicles, with seating capacity of seven to twelve passengers excluding the driver and having company fitted body (hard top) four wheeler duly approved by ARAI or any other agency as approved by the Govt. of India for this purpose.
2. The vehicle shall ply on clean fuel (i.e. CNG, O.E.) complying with Bharat Stage-IV Norms, fitted with Global Positioning System (GPS) and connect to the Control Room of the Transport Department at the terms and payments as may be decided by the Govt of NCT of Delhi time to time. These vehicles shall be

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registered under same series i.e. DL 1Q and will be called as 'Phatphat Sewa' and shall be granted contract carriage permit as per provisions of MV Act and rules made thereunder.

3. The vehicles will operate as ordinary transport vehicle on Contract Carriage Permits (without fare meter).
 4. The colour of the vehicle registered under Phatphat Sewa scheme shall be Cherry colour.
 5. The vehicle will be eligible for registration as Transport Vehicle and grant of Contract Carriage Permits, subject to fitness, payment of prescribed fees and taxes etc.
 6. The vehicles registered as 'Phatphat Sewa' will be allowed to ply only on the prescribed routes as per list placed at annexure A.
 7. The vehicles should have First-aid Box & Fire extinguisher.
 8. The name, address and telephone number of permit holder shall be painted on the rear exterior body of the vehicle.
 9. The Helpline Number (42-400-400) of the Transport Department & Traffic Police No. is (1091) shall also be displayed on both inside and outside of the vehicle.
 10. The vehicle must be of such model which will not have height more than 2.5 meters and standing shall not be allowed.
- 18 All vehicles shall be required to obtain certificate of fitness under Section 56 of the MV Act and conform to the prevailing tail pipe Mass Emission Standards and safety norms and mandatory compliance thereafter.

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PERMIT CONDITIONS FOR PHATPHAT SEWA VEHICLES

1. Vehicles seeking to ply as Phatphat Sewa shall be granted contract carriage permit on an application made under section 73 of the M V Act with particulars such as type and seating capacity of the vehicle as shown in the certificate of registration and other particulars, as may be prescribed. However, such vehicles shall not qualify for Inter-State permits / All India Tourist permits.

2. **GPS / GPRS DEVICES**

The owner/permit holder or the driver authorized by the permit holder/owner to drive the vehicle shall have the vehicle fitted with GPS/GPRS and other equipment authorized by the department through DIMTS after payment as may be detailed by the department and as per schedule notified by the department.

a) The permit holder/driver will keep the GPS/GPRS device and other equipments installed as a part of system in good working condition and shall bear the cost in the event of any loss, will full / accidental damage, theft etc.,

b) The Permit holder shall make his vehicle available for inspection/repair of GPS/GPRS the vendors as authorized by the DIMTS within the 24 hours of lodging complaint regarding theft/loss/damage etc. Failing which penalty as prescribed for violation of permit condition shall be imposed.

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- c) The Panic button to be installed in the Phatphat Sewa Vehicles by DIMTS/authorized vendor near passengers sitting area is to be in working condition in communication with control of Central Command Centre set by the DIMTS and statutory authorities.
- d) The driver shall take the passenger to his destination through the specified route only.
3. The vehicle shall be plied only on the route specified after the allocation of routes. The permit holder shall display at front and rear the originating & destination point and route via on the left side of the vehicle.
 4. Permit issued shall not be transferable for a minimum period of one year except in the case of death or disability/insanity of the permit holder.
 5. The fares shall be charged from passenger at rates approved by the Transport Department, Delhi i.e. @ of Rs. 5, Rs. 10, and Rs. 15/-, Rs. 5 for the first 03 K.M. and Rs. 10 upto 07 K.M. and above 07 K.M Rs. 15/-. The fare table shall be displayed prominently outside & inside the vehicle.
 6. The Colour of the vehicle registered under Phatphat Sewa scheme shall be Cherry Colour with inscription of 'Phatphat Sewa' in between the horizontal stripes.
 7. (i) Passenger shall not be carried in excess of the seating capacity of the vehicle i.e. seven to twelve passengers excluding the driver.
(ii) The vehicle must be of such model which will not have height more than 2.5 meters and standing shall not be allowed.
 8. The permit holder shall ensure that the vehicle undergoes quarterly CNG leakage test from the workshops of OEM's duly authorized by the Transport Department, Govt. of Delhi.
 9. The following safety considerations shall be deemed mandatory fitness / permit conditions for all Phatphat Sewa registration under this scheme:
 - (a) The drivers of such vehicles covered under this scheme shall be required to undergo driver training including refresher driving training as may be prescribed by the Commissioner, Transport, Govt. of NCT of Delhi from time to time.

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- (b) The vehicle shall be equipped with the following, namely-
- (i) First Aid Box (Rule 66 of DMVR).
 - (ii) Fire extinguisher (dry powder type)
 - (iii) Any other requirement as specified
10. (i) Vehicles shall be kept in neat and clean condition ensuring the comfort and convenience of the passengers without endangering the safety of the passengers i.e. unauthorized alteration of vehicle such as providing special platform at the rear and both sides of the vehicle, keeping the rear window opened to facilitate the seating of passengers etc. will not be permitted.
- (ii) The permit holder shall exercise such supervision as is necessary to ensure that the vehicle is operated in conformity with the motor vehicle act and rules made thereunder with due regard for the comfort, convenience and safety of passengers carried and shall not use or cause or allow to use the vehicle in the commission of an offence under the Indian Penal Code or local or special laws or any statutory control order.
11. The name and address / telephone of the permit holder shall be painted or otherwise firmly affixed to the Phatpat Sewa on the rear exterior of the body.
12. The driver shall be cleanly dressed and shall wear grey uniform with PSV (Public service vehicle) badge.
13. While on duty, the driver shall not be under the influence of drugs / liquor. He shall also not play audio device in the vehicle during duty hours.
14. The Transport Department's Helpline number will be displayed prominently inside and outside the vehicle.
15. The permit holder / driver, as the case may be of the Phatpat Sewa shall be liable forthwith for suspension / cancellation of the permit and revocation of the driving license, as the case may be, in case of accident resulting in fatalities.
16. Phatpat Sewa Vehicle shall be driven by a driver who holds an effective driving license issued to him, authorizing him to drive the vehicle.
17. The conditions of the permit so granted shall not be departed from save with the approval of the State Transport Authority.

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18. The permit holder should ensure that the vehicle is driven by the authorized driver having authorization card issued by the department and permit holder shall be fully responsible for any kind of violation of provisions of MV Act and the Rules made thereunder.
19. No hypothecation of these vehicles in favor of individual shall be allowed nor will any change of hypothecation from Bank/Govt. financial institution to individual be allowed.
20. Except in the circumstance of exceptional nature, the plying of the vehicle or carrying of the passengers shall not be refused.
21. General conditions attached to all permits u/s 84 of MV Act are applicable for the Phatphat Sewa Permit Holders.
22. The vehicle shall all time comply the provisions of Motor Vehicle Act and Rules made thereunder.
23. State Transport Authority may, after giving notice of not less than one month -
 - (a) Vary the conditions of the permit
 - (b) Attach to the permit further conditions
24. No hazardous chemicals or explosive etc. will be allowed to be carried in the vehicle.
