NOTIFICATION

No. F. 25(01)/2007/Tpt/Ops / __.- The following draft of rules further to amend the Delhi Motor Vehicles Rules, 1993, which the Lieutenant Governor of the National Capital Territory of Delhi proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by section 65 read with clause (41) of section 2 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988) is hereby published as required by sub-section (1) of section 212 of the said Act for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft will be taken into consideration after the expiry of a period of thirty days from the date of publication of this notification in the Delhi Gazette together with any objections or suggestions that may be received in respect thereto by the stipulated period.

Draft Rules

Short Title and Commencement	(1)	(1) These rules may be called the Delhi Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Rules, 2012.
		(2) They shall come into force on the date of their final publication in the Delhi Gazette.
Insertion of rule 34A	(2)	In the Delhi Motor Vehicles Rules, 1993, after rule 34, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:- “34A. Fee for the assignment of Registration Mark of

choice.-----

- (1) In the case of a non-transport four wheeled vehicle, the assignment of a registration mark, as specified in column 1 of the Table given below, in any of the available series of registration marks shall only be made by auctioning on payment of additional fee, as bidded by the highest bidder. The minimum reserve price for such registration marks shall be as mentioned in column 2 of the Table:
- (2) The allotment of such registration marks shall be made by an officer authorized by the Principal Secretary-cum-Commissioner (Transport).
- (3) The allotment of such registration marks, as may be available, in respect of four wheeled non-transport vehicles shall be made by open bidding/auctioning to be done on fortnightly basis. The applicant will indicate their choice of registration mark in advance so that the availability of such registration marks can be checked and blocked in the system for open auction.
- (4) The allotment of such registration mark shall be valid only for ninety days of its issue. In case, the allottee fails to register the vehicle within ninety days, the same can be re-issued by the Transport department to any other person through bidding process and the fee paid by the initial allottee shall be forfeited.
- (5) The official vehicles owned by Government of NCT of Delhi and its undertaking and Central Government, as specified in Annexure-I will be exempted from the provisions of this rule and no additional fees will be charged for allotment of such registration marks.
- (6) The dignitaries/officers specified in Annexure-I shall be eligible for allotment of such registration marks for the vehicle to be registered in their own name without payment of additional fee, limited to maximum of two such registration marks during their tenure. However, the sale/ transfer of ownership of a vehicle bearing such a registration mark to a non-eligible person, within one year of its initial registration, shall be allowed only on the payment of the minimum reserved price fixed for that registration mark.”
